- Provide an environment which is stimulating and welcoming to all

Rewards

Rewards are a form of positive reinforcement in use in Moneynick. Praise can be given in many ways.

In Moneynick rewards may include:

- an encouraging smile
- verbal praise or round of applause
- visit from principal on following day
- word of praise to person collecting child
- presentation of prize
- first choice in activities



Club Discipline

Sanctions

It is necessary to have sanctions so as to make the particular child and others aware that certain behaviour is unacceptable. Sanctions are also in place to protect the safety of all members of the club, and the authority of the leader and helpers, should that be threatened. Bullying of any sort will not be tolerated.

In Moneynick sanctions may include:

- a look of disapproval
- immediate verbal checking of misbehaviour
- a minor penalty relative to the offence
- time out
- referral to the Principal
- parental consultation
- the drawing up of a behaviour plan



Club Rules

We promote an environment that is safe and welcoming and therefore have some rules for all to follow.

- Children are expected to show respect for others at all times
- Children must move safely around the premises no running
- Children must promptly obey instructions from club leaders and helpers
- Children should remember their manners at all times
- Bullying will be regarded as severe indiscipline and will not be tolerated
