Key Learning Points/Aims

1	Practice of literacy and numeracy problem solving skills
2	Learning about the diversity of prehistoric life
3	Using natural materials to create a piece of artwork
4	Observing and appreciating the natural world

Lesson Structure (including timings):

Pre Activity:

- Hide the dinosaur footprint clues in various locations in your garden or local greenspace.

Activity 1 – Prehistoric Prowl!

- Pupils run around the area to track down the dinosaur footprints!
- Match the numbered footprints to the dinosaur who left them behind!

Activity 3: Natural dinosaur art (15 mins)

- Collect natural materials to stick onto their dinosaur's body to fill/colour it in. Remind pupils that they should only be collecting materials that have fallen onto the floor and should not pick leaves off of live trees etc.
